What does Transition mean?

Transition means moving from one thing to another, everyone experiences different transitions throughout their life and whenever we experience them, we all handle them in different ways or have different feelings about them.

Moving class can come with lots of different feelings. Teachers from both classes work together to make sure that all students feel supported when moving to a new class. You may have been expecting that before you moved class you would:

- *Meet with your new class teacher*
- *Get to visit your new classroom*
- *Find out the topics you might be learning about next year*

As schools are closed, the transition from one class to another might not be the same this year and it is completely normal to worry about missing the things you were expecting to happen as part of your preparation. Although all the details about moving class may not have been released yet your teachers are working hard to be able to prepare you:

- *Your current and new teacher may contact you at home to talk you through moving class and see how you are.*
- *You may have some activities and information sent home to prepare you for the new school year and answer some of your questions.*

Whilst things are uncertain, there are some things you can prepare that might help you to feel more ready for when you start your new school:

Practical Ideas to Prepare for Transition:

- Keep an eye on your school website and social media, there is often lots of useful information being shared here.
- Find out what you need for the new school year, equipment, uniform and have these ready.
- Get in touch with school and ask questions if you are unsure or worried about something.
- Find out if your school has a Young Carers Lead so that you can speak to them if you need to.
